We want to inform you that 4 children have been admitted to the house: Jesus (6 years old), Angel (9 years old), Alexa (10 years old), and Carolina (15 years old). We ask for your prayers for them that the Lord allows them to restore their lives.

We continue preparing the children's choir and Reyna, Sara, and Bruno continue their piano lessons. Leticia has finished the eighth semester of the Dentistry Degree, we ask for your prayers for her as she finishes her last semester of dental school. By God's grace, He has supplied what is needed so that she can continue with her study, and it is a blessing to have her in the University. She has been treating the dental needs of the children, and is currently treating Chucho's dental needs.



We appreciate the faithfulness of God and his care. Despite going through the trials to which we have been subjected, we know that we count on His love and care. It has been two months since my hospitalization, and after having several laboratory tests, a Hepatobiliary ultrasound and a FibroScan, a diagnosis was made: Liver failure. I have some terrible days, such as Monday of last week, I had a fever all day, diarrhea, vomiting and a strong stomach and head pain. Wednesday I only had a bad headache, and now my health is stable. I have begun a very rigorous nutritional treatment, which is very expensive but I can begin to feel a little bit of improvement. It has not been easy but with the help of God I hope to improve some every day. I will have labwork done periodically to monitor if there is a change in these areas.

We thank you infinitely for your prayers and your financial support recognizing that "He that hath a bountiful eye shall be blessed; for he giveth of his bread to the poor." (Proverbs 22:9) We pray that the Lord will continue to bless you greatly in your lives and in your ministries.
