Warm greetings to each of you. We hope in the faithfulness of our God that you are very well and serving our God.

I thank each of you who have been praying for my wife. As some of you know, in January she suffered an accident that broke a bone in the sole of her foot. She had to be taken to the emergency room. Thank God, she did not require surgery, but only a cast for her leg. The material they used was fiberglass, not a heavy plaster cast that is commonly used here for fractures. God has given us grace to be able to work and take care of our girls because although it is difficult to do things, we know that love can do everything. There was an expense of \$800 dollars for medical expenses, adding to the \$250 dollars for medications and supplies from the doctor. Thank God, he has supplied us with all these expenses and with your help, both financially and in prayer, we have been strengthened in the Lord.

On Monday, March 4, she will go back for a checkup for her foot and praying that God has already healed the bone and the cast can be removed so that rehabilitation can begin. I continue to ask for your prayers so that my wife can walk without any problem and there are no lasting effects of the fracture.

At the San Lucas mission, we had a special time with the children, because we had a special day where each of the children received a present and they were very happy. We continue witnessing and sharing in the rehabilitation center. Praise God, we have had people saved and we are making plans for the last Saturday of April to have baptisms. God has blessed us greatly in the different missions.



In February, we had two activities. The first was the couples dinner and special youth meeting. The topic we discussed was "True Friendship". It allowed us to have 17 adults and 23 youth, praise God! We had a good time and were challenged in our hearts by the Word of God. The second event was our "Friend's Day" where we invited people so they could join us and receive the Word of God. God allowed us to have 8 guests and in total there were 94 people at the service. We continue to ask for his prayers so that more people hear the message of salvation and can be added to the Ebenezer Baptist Mission.



We continue with Bible studies in the mission of Tecámac, with services on Wednesdays and Sundays in the mission of Texcoco. The brothers of Texcoco are starting a mission in “Chiconcuac”, where there are saved people and the doors of a home have been opened where they are receiving Bible studies. Also by the grace of God, brother Ricardo Rivas opened a mission in Acolman Centro, where they are meeting on Sunday afternoons for Bible studies. They began the first Sunday of February and God has allowed them to see people interested and participating in the studies. I ask for your prayers for Brother Ricardo so that God continues to direct and bless him and his entire family.

We continue with the ministry to the Jews. God has allowed our sister Elena and her daughter Mekare to be able to share the Word of our God to His people Israel. We ask you to pray for them because in April they will be going to the country of Israel as missionaries and their stay in the country will be 3 months.
